*Clinical Training Notes:

PSY 500 Clinical Training Orientation

Clinical Training Orientation is required for all first quarter students and for any MAP student who has not yet attended it. This seminar is held during the New Student Orientation & Registration meeting. It is a prerequisite to begin Clinical Training. This seminar is the beginning of the Clinical Training process. Students learn about the requirements for the MAP degree and for MFT licensure, how to go about finding a training site, what resources are available and how to use them. This meeting is only offered

once each quarter

PSY 500A PERFECT

PERFECT is required for all MAP students to complete one quarter prior to registering for their first Clinical Traineeship. It is a prerequisite to begin Clinical Training. This seminar is the continuation of the information discussed in Clinical Training Orientation. In the PERFECT seminar, the paperwork required to contract with a training site, to register for Clinical Training academic units, and to track hours for Antioch and the BBS is explained. This seminar is now completed via

computer as a computer-based tutorial available on FirstClass.
